

## Undergraduate Placement Exam and Information

For Portuguese

### Fall 2014

For all students who missed the placement exam, a make-up online version will be offered on SUNDAY, AUGUST 24th from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM.

**You must complete the exam by 9 pm.**

The Portuguese Placement exam's sole purpose is to correctly place you in the proper level so that you will get the most out of your academic experience in one of our courses. Your exam will be evaluated by our department and you will be placed in the appropriate level. The exam is to be taken by you without any outside help or access to resources or materials.

Exemptions. If you have any of the following scores:

- 1) L5 on the Yale Portuguese placement exam, or
- 2) if you have successfully completed L4 (PORT 140) at Yale,

With any one of those listed scores or courses, you do not have to take the placement exam, and may register directly for any L5 course.

If you missed the regularly scheduled exam, the online make-up exam will be available on **Sunday, August 24, from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. You must complete the exam by 9:00 p.m.**

Please Note: If you are a Heritage Speaker (if you have been exposed to Portuguese, either at home or by living in a Portuguese-speaking county, but have little or no formal training in the language), please contact an instructor who will personally evaluate your level. Please do not take the General Placement Exam.

Students who have never studied Portuguese, formally or informally, do not have to take the full exam but must fill out a brief questionnaire on the same site (<http://classesv2.yale.edu>) prior to pre-registration.

Students will need their NetID to log on to access the questionnaire and exam on Sunday, August 24, from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
