

Mandatory Pre-registration for Places in Spanish Language Courses, Levels L1-L4

All students who wish to take a Spanish Language course in Levels L1 through L4 (SPAN 110, SPAN 120, SPAN 130, SPAN 140), must pre-register through Preference Selection during the Online Pre-registration period: **8:30 a.m. on December 8, 2014 through 5:00 p.m. on January 8, 2015.**

Note: Graduate students cannot preregister online. They must contact the appropriate course director, whose name is listed below with the course level.

Note: For students who intend to enroll in Intensive Intermediate Spanish (SPAN 145), which meets five days a week for two hours each day, or in Spanish for Heritage Speakers II (SPAN 142): register directly at OCS for the one section offered. **All other undergraduate students** follow the links below.

For students who have just taken the Department's placement exam:

You must follow the link below for your placement exam result level. For example, if you have placed into L2, you will follow the L2 preference selection link to register for SPAN 120.

For students who have already taken a Spanish language course at Yale:

You will follow the link below for the next appropriate course in the sequence. For example, if you have already taken SPAN 110, you will follow the L2 preference selection link to register for SPAN 120.

After entering your Yale NetID and Password, you will select your top 3 preferences from a list of available sections for your assigned level. Places will be assigned on the basis of a computerized selection. Notice of assignments will be available the evening of **Sunday, January 11, 2015**. You will again enter your Yale NetID and Password to find your section registration information.

To secure your place in the section, you must attend ALL meetings of the class. Instructors will start waiting lists the first day of classes, and any open or unclaimed seats will immediately be filled from the names on the waiting list.
