Professor Rafael Rojas

Rafael Rojas is a distinguished Cuban and Caribbean historian and cultural critic and a prizewinning scholar and writer of Latin American history. He is a faculty member at the Centro de Investigación y Docencia Económica (CIDE) in Mexico City, and is currently Presidential Visiting Professor in Yale's Department of Spanish and Portuguese. Among his numerous works of cultural and intellectual history are: *Tumbas sin sosiego: revolución, disidencia y el exilio del intelectual cubano* (2006), which won the prestigious Premio Anagrama de Ensayo in 2006, *Las repúblicas de aire. Utopía y desencanto en la Revolución de Hispanoamérica*, winner of the first Isabel de Polanco Essay Award in 2009, and more recently, *Historia mínima de la Revolución Cubana* (2015) and *Fighting Over Fidel. The Cuban Revolution and the New York Intellectuals* (2016).
